- ②Shift the gear to Neutral (N) or Parked (P) with Parking Brake ON.
- ③Remove Jacks, Lift, and Jack Stands from a vehicle then confirm all 4 wheels touches ground.

#### Regular Maintenance


Inspect installed CUSCO parts regularly for safety and comfort.

Drive with Caution, Sway bar changes handling characteristic of vehicles.


- •Re-Torque installed CUSCO parts regularly.

# Removal of OEM Front Sway Bar

- ① Remove Front Tires.
- ② Remove Front Bumper.
  - ·Remove 2 bolts from top of a bumper and 4 clips.
  - ·Disconnect Left and Right fender joints.
  - •Remove Undercover and Fender Front Liners.
  - · Disconnect electrical connectors then remove the front bumper.




3 Remove both Left and Right ABS sensor wires from upper arms.



Remove steering rack bolts (indicated below #4)




⑤ Remove both Left and Right brackets shown below. (4 bolts per side)





© Remove Left and Right cross member covers. (2 bolts per side)






Remove 2 bolts from both Left and Right front sections. (2 bolts per side)

® Support the cross member and the engine with transmission jacks.






- Loosen the both side's cross member bolts and nuts. (3 bolts per side)DO NOT remove the bolts and nuts, please ensure the nuts are engaged at least 3 turns.
- ① Lower the cross member by 30mm.


Caution: Place jacks then start lowering the cross member for safety caution.








② Shift the steering rack towards to front without putting stress on steering shaft.




Remove both side's sway bar end links and brackets.





② Slide the OEM sway bar over the tie rods then towards to front.












Slide the sway bar to left, careful not to touch air conditioning pipes.









Front Sway Bar Installation
